# LET™

The Let™ lounge chair is a low lounge chair with a fine silhouette and sculptural design by Sebastian Herkner for Fritz Hansen. The seat cushion visually ‘floats’ on the frame, surrounded by an enveloping backrest. Let embodies the German designer’s skills and aesthetic, with Fritz Hansen’s expert craftsmanship. It is designed for a wide variety of expressions and interior styles.

## DESIGNER

Sebastian Herkner (born 1981) studied Product Design at HfG Offenbach University of Art and Design. During his studies he began to focus on designing objects and furniture, honing his keen sense for materials, colors and textures. Sebastian Herkner founded his own studio in 2006.

His works have won numerous accolades – among others the IF Award, the Iconic Award and the Elle Deco International Design Award (EDIDA). As Guest of Honor to imm cologne 2016, Sebastian Herkner provided the design for “Das Haus”. Maison&Objet has elected him 2019 “Designer of the Year”.

## MODELS

SH200: Lounge chair w. wooden base  
SH210: Lounge chair w. steel base

## MATERIAL

**Shell:** The shell of the Let™ lounge chair consists of a fully upholstered seat and backrest. Both are made from moulded foam with an embedded inner steel frame.

**Base:** The wooden base is made of solid wood and comes in 3 finishes. The steel base is made of Ø18 mm steel tubes and comes in chromed or powder coated steel. Both base options are mounted with black spacers and comes with elastomer glides.

### Materials in %:

SH200: Wood 17%, Steel 41%, PUR 42%  
SH210: Steel 56%, PUR 44%

*Items with a weight <1% of the total product weight are not included in the figures.  
The upholstery percentage may vary depending on the upholstery type.*

## UPHOLSTERY

The upholstery for Let is available in the following selection of fabric and leather types:

**Fabric:** Christianshavn™, Canvas, Fame, Remix, Tonus, Hue\*, Loop\*, Rewool, Divina, Divina Melange, Divina MD, Fiord, Hallingdal, Steelcut, Steelcut Trio, Sunniva, Vidar

\*Special terms apply for colours and minimum order quantity. Hue is not compatible for US market. Hue & Loop require fire treatment for UK market.

**Leather:** Essential.

## MADE-TO-ORDER

Non-standard configurations; special colours, upholstery (COM/COL) etc., are available upon request at a minimum order quantity.

## PRODUCTION PROCESS

**Shell:** The backrest is made from PUR-foam moulded around an inner steel frame. The seat is also made from PUR-foam moulded around a steel frame with nozag springs. The two pieces are upholstered individually and assembled.

**Base:** The wood base is made from CNC milled solid wood. After gluing, all bases are sanded and finished with a PU lacquer. The steel base is made from bended and welded steel tubes and is available in either chromed steel or powder coated steel.

Fritz Hansen uses both trivalent chromium (Cr3) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6) for chromium plating. Fritz Hansen will convert to solely using trivalent chromium (Cr3) when the capacity in the Industry allows it.

**PACKAGING**

The lounge chair is covered with a recycled plastic bag and shipped in a recycled cardboard box. All packaging material can be recycled.

**CLEANING AND CARE**

**Upholstery:** Vacuum frequently on medium power, ideally every week. Remove wet stains by carefully dabbing with a lint-free cloth or sponge wrung in warm detergent-free water. If the stain remains, we recommend the chemical dry cleaning product K2R ([www.k2rbrands.com](http://www.k2rbrands.com)). No other chemicals or detergents can be used. This also applies to steam cleaning.

**NOTE!** Do not rub the material with force. This could damage the fabric and cause loss of colour. No upholstered furniture should be exposed to direct sunlight or be placed close to a radiator or fireplace.

**Lacquered wood:**

Wipe the surface with a clean cloth. Stains and dirt can be removed from the furniture with a clean cloth wrung in water, or in a solution of hot water and a universal cleaning detergent (ammonia acceptable), soap flakes (1/4dl (decilitre) soap flakes for 1 litre hot water, cooled), a washing detergent or hot water with about 10% vinegar. Finally, wipe off the table top with a clean, dry cloth.

Lacquered surfaces do not stand moisture, heat or alcohol. All spilt liquids must therefore be wiped up immediately.

**Powder coated surfaces:** Clean the plastic shell by wiping it with a dry cloth. Dirt can be removed with a cloth wrung out in lukewarm water. If this does not remove the dirt, a mild solution containing a universal cleaning agent or dishwashing liquid may be used. Then dry off the shell with a cloth wrung out in clean water and finish by wiping with a dry cloth.

**Chromed surfaces:** Chrome can be wiped with a dry or damp cloth wrung in soapy water, and then wiped with a dry cloth afterwards.

**NOTE!** Do not use solvents on coated frames. thorough cleaning For thorough cleaning chrome surfaces can be wiped with a cloth moistened with alcohol.

**REPAIR, DISPOSAL AND REUSE**

In case of repair and disposal of the lounge chair, the bases and spacers can be disassembled from the shell. In case of disposal, bases and spacers can be sorted for recycling. Check local regulations for recycling options and whether there is potential for reuse. The seat and backrest requires special handling due to the embedded steel frames.

**WARRANTY**

Fritz Hansen provides a five-year warranty on standard products against defects in materials and workmanship.


