



PK51™ & PK55™

PK51™ and PK55™ are two rectangular tables designed by Poul Kjærholm in 1957. Both tables have an ash veneer table top that is supported by a satin brushed stainless steel frame with four legs. The PK51 worktable was the first to be launched together with the PK11™ chair as a matching set. Later, PK55 was launched as a smaller version of PK51.




PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The PK51™ and PK55™ tables both have a table top in ash veneer. The frame for both tables is made of satin brushed stainless steel and consists of four components.

POUL KJÆRHOLM 1929-1980


Poul Kjærholm was a trained cabinet maker and continued his studies at the Danish School of Arts and Crafts in Copenhagen. He had a particular interest in different construction materials, especially steel, which he considered a natural material with the same artistic fineness as other natural materials.

Poul Kjærholm was first employed at Fritz Hansen for about a year, where he designed a number of noteworthy chair prototypes. In 1955, Poul Kjærholm initiated his collaboration with manufacturer Ejvind Kold Christensen, which lasted until Kjærholm's death in 1980. In 1982, Fritz Hansen took over the manufacture and sales of "The Kjærholm Collection", which was developed over the period 1951 to 1967.


